

"Private" Functions

A lot of successful weddings, family reunions & private celebrations are held at Camp Wainui. These bookings are very welcome but they have different charges and rules/conditions from our standard policy, which is designed for school/youth groups and not-for-profit organisations.

- The booking must be made by the person responsible for the whole event, with contact name, numbers and address supplied. This person, who signs the booking form, is responsible financially for any damages/cleaning costs which may be incurred.
- The full lodge complex must be hired (cannot be part booked). Full lodge hire per 24hr period \$1000.
- If the booking is for a **long** weekend 3 x nights is a minimum booking Total stay is \$3000.00. Peak season **September through to May** for any weekend booking a minimum of two nights needs to be booked. Minimum lodge hire for 48hr period is \$2000
- A deposit of \$400 needs to be received within 2 weeks of booking to be confirmed. A confirmation will be sent on receipt of the deposit with booking details and balance due.
- For any "Private Function" or Alcohol is on site a \$400 bond is required on <u>arrival</u> (separate from deposit or balance of hire) and is refundable on final inspection (if all conditions are met) within 1-2 days after departure.
- Full balance to be paid on arrival
- All rules & cleaning instructions inside units and hall must be followed.
- The hall can be decorated and the area set up as you wish but needs to be "left as found" with all waste placed in the skip and your personal property/materials removed from site before departure.
- Unsupervised alcohol consumption at youth gatherings is not allowed on these premises.
- Camp Wainui does not have 18th, 21st & after-ball parties
- If the event to be held is not what was stated at time of booking (such as booking for 50th but is really a 21st) or the booking is misleading, Camp Wainui reserves the right to cancel the booking and the deposit is non-refundable.
- If a booking has been confirmed and the event does not occur, with no notice of cancellation or insufficient time is given to re-book dates, the balance due on confirmation will be invoiced to the person responsible for the event. If no payment is received the debt will be sent to a debt collector.
