CAMP WAINUI'S GRATTAN BUSHLINE HUT

The Grattan Hut is similar to a DOC hut and is designed to provide a 'kiwi camping experience' for family groups and youth groups.

Description

The hut is solidly built and completely lined. It is well away from other parts of the camp in a bush setting. It has no electricity.

Cooking

No cooking equipment or cooking/eating utensils are provided. Most groups bring their own gas barbeques. Water from the nearby stream is available on tap. Mains water, for filling drinking bottles, is available from Skip Turley Block (almost 400m away). Ample bench and storage space is available.

Dining

Indoor 'picnic tables' are available (plus seats on the verandah).

Ablutions

Outside "long drops" are a short distance from the hut. The toilet and shower facilities in Skip Turley Block are available to Grattan Hut users.

Sleeping

Sleeping platforms on two levels would accommodate about 24 people. Some mattresses are provided. A suitable area for pitching tents is nearby.

Surroundings

Set amidst native bush and scrub overlooking much of the campsite, the hut is well away from other campers. There are good walking tracks near the hut. The lighting of fires is only permitted if prior approval is obtained from the Camp Manager.

Charges

Overnight charges are currently \$5 per person per night.
